Information is obtained through the Michigan Disease Surveillance System (MDSS). Data provided is for confirmed cases only unless otherwise noted as probable.






Known source of exposure has been identified for less than half of the cases.

 Of those unassociated with an outbreak, 103 cases are community contacts meaning they are connected to another positive COVID-19 case not within the same household

233 cases are associated with a named outbreak

Of those unassociated with an outbreak, 303 cases are household contacts meaning they are connected to another positive COVID-19 case within the same household



Less than half of the cases were symptomatic during their course of illness.*






Asymptomatic
