

# COVID-19 Missaukee County Monthly Summary - January 2022

The purpose of this monthly summary is to provide you with more information regarding cases referred to the health department over the past month. Information is obtained through the Michigan Disease Surveillance System (MDSS). Data provided is for confirmed cases only unless otherwise noted as probable.

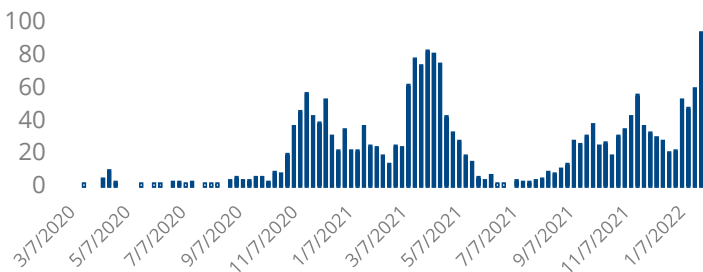
**There was an increase in confirmed COVID-19 cases this month as last month.**



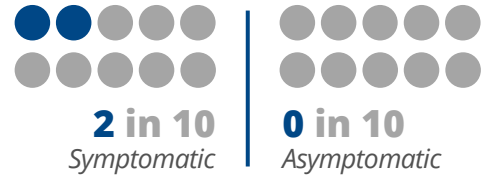
**Known source of exposure has been identified for less than half of the cases.**

- 1** 10 cases are associated with outbreaks at care facilities and school
- 2** Of those unassociated with an outbreak, 1 case is a community contact meaning they are connected to another positive COVID-19 case not within the same household
- 3** Of those unassociated with an outbreak, 10 cases are household contacts meaning they are connected to another positive COVID-19 case within the same household

**Less than half of the cases were symptomatic during their course of illness.\***

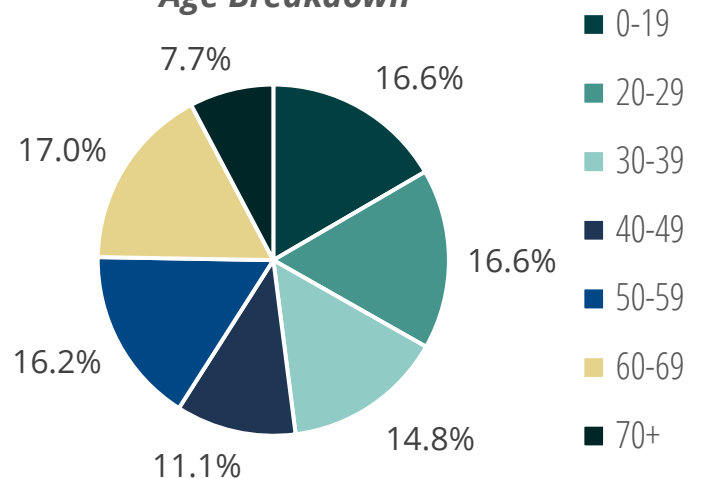


Please note: Symptomatic and Asymptomatic are both contagious
