The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that everyone between the ages of 13 and 64 get tested for HIV at least once as part of routine health care. DHD#10 offers rapid HIV tests and can provide results in 20 minutes. DHD#10 asks that residents attending the walk-in testing clinics please bring insurance cards. However, insurance is not required for testing or any vaccinations. If residents cannot attend a walk-in clinic, an HIV test can be scheduled at any DHD#10 location by calling 888-217-3904. Services are confidential, LGBTQ friendly, and no one will ever be denied service due to inability to pay. Walk-ins are also welcome, or you can order a free at-home HIV test kit to test yourself at your convenience.
