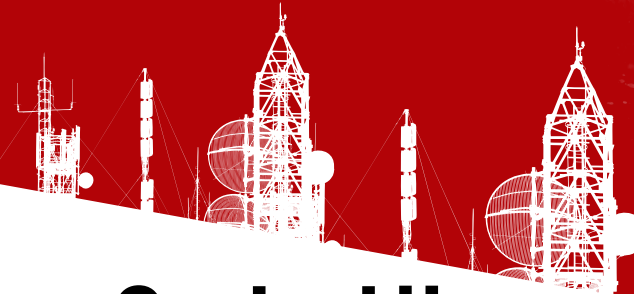

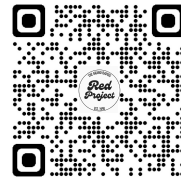

It is a basic human right to have access to the tools, information, resources, and support to live healthy and safe lives.

General Services

Clean Works Harm Reduction

A syringe access and needle exchange program which provides sterile, personal substance use equipment to participants.

Overdose Prevention and Response

Educates community members on how to prevent, recognize, and respond to an opioid overdose with Naloxone hydrochloride (Narcan).

Recovery Coaching

Assists participants with substance use disorder in accessing community health and social services, such as medical and mental health services, housing, food, and transportation.

HIV Medical Case Management

Assists People Living with HIV (PLWH) in accessing community health and social services, such as medical and mental health services, housing, food, and transportation.

HIV/Hepatitis C (HCV) Prevention

We provide free, rapid response HIV/HCV testing, counseling, and referrals - along with safe sex supplies. (i.e. external and internal condoms and lubrication)

PrEP Navigation Services

Assists participants with education and access to Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) medications, both pill and injection regimens.

Linkage to Care Services

Provides linkage to medical care for people newly diagnosed with HIV, or people living with HIV who are not currently in medical treatment.

HIV+ Tobacco Cessation Program

Provides support, education, and assistance in accessing community resources to reduce tobacco and nicotine use in PLWH.

WHAT IS PREP?

Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis is a medication that when taken properly can prevent HIV in the body when exposed. PrEP works for all genders.
